This Privacy Policy explains how The Mothership Network (“Company,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) collects, uses, discloses, and protects information when you access or use our website, applications, and related services (collectively, the “Services”). Information We Collect

We collect information to operate our platform, support user interactions, and improve the Services.

Information You Provide

- Contact information such as name, email address, phone number, and mailing address
- Account credentials and profile details
- Content you submit, including posts, messages, uploads, and communications
- Payment information processed through secure third-party providers

Information Collected Automatically

How We Use Your Information

We use personal and technical information to:

- Create and manage user accounts
- Process payments and verify transactions
- Communicate with you about updates, features, or support needs
- Personalize content and user experience
- Monitor security, detect fraud, and enforce platform rules
- Comply with legal, regulatory, or contractual obligations

We may also use aggregated or anonymized data for analytics, research, and service improvement.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- Enable essential site functionality
- Remember user preferences and settings
- Analyze usage patterns and improve performance
- Support advertising and marketing efforts

You may disable cookies through your browser settings, though certain features may not function properly.

How We Share Information

We do **not** sell personal information. We may share information with:

- **Service providers** supporting hosting, analytics, payments, customer support, or security
- **Legal authorities** when required to comply with law, court orders, or to protect rights and safety
- **Business partners** assisting with platform functionality or integrations
- **Successors or acquirers** in the event of a merger, restructuring, or asset transfer

All third parties must protect your information and use it only for authorized purposes.

Data Security

We use administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or disclosure. While we strive to protect your data, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure.

Your Rights and Choices
